CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Limit of **two entries** per artist.
2. Entry must be the **original work** of the artist. Please be mindful of copyright laws.
3. Entry fee is **\$5.00 per work**. Free for Gallery members. Please include return postage payment if work is required to be returned by post.
4. Each work is to convey a threatened species, biodiversity and/or conservation message/s. Graphic design entries allowed.
5. Width no larger than 500mm (including frame) due to hanging space. 3D footprint no larger than 300mm x 300mm.
6. All work to be **framed & delivered ready to hang** with D hooks and wire. The display team reserves the right to refuse to accept works for any reason & to determine the most appropriate means of displaying work.
7. Each work must be securely labelled on rear with **title, artist's name, address, contact number and selling price**.
8. Medium: **Any medium except photography**.
9. While the Courthouse and Segue Galleries are secure and great care will be taken with your work, they accept no liability for loss, damage or theft of your work. It is your responsibility to arrange insurance cover if desired.
10. Commission on sales is 20% of the listed price and payment is made by cheque within two weeks of exhibition concluding.
11. Art work can be dropped off at WGCMA offices in Leongatha, Traralgon or Maffra by November 07, 2018. Call 1300 094 262 for details.
